



Publishing Platform for Retail Print Control Service 11.0 Release Notes

The Lexmark™ Publishing Platform for Retail (PPR) signage solution is a system for printing and publishing signs, labels, and tags that are used in retail stores.

The PPR solution is a server application. It has different web solutions to be used in the store and headquarters.

Users must install the Print Control service in a local machine to do the following:

- Printing a signage to a local printer from a store application
- Printing from a headquarters application (such as Central Publisher)

This document provides information on the versions of the Print Control service and its release history.

Release History

Version 11.0, released September 2021

- Improved experience in uninstalling and upgrading the component.
- Print Control service is now independent of the application version.
- Merged Print Control DLL and the Print Control service as one single software in the installed software list in Windows.

Notes:

- Print Control Service v11.0 is released alongside PPR v10.4.
- All v10.4 PPR web apps are compatible with Print Control v11.0.
- For upcoming PPR releases, the user must refer to the latest PPR release note to verify if Print Control Service v11.0 is compatible with the latest PPR web apps.

Issues fixed

- Incident # 658371: Print Control now pops up in front of other Windows applications.
- Incident # 654460: Client-side printing now supports the two-sided (duplex) print setting.
- Incident # 652041: Print control now handles the switch between In-Store Publisher and Central Publisher (CP).
- Incident # 668585: Print Control Service certificate now lists 127.0.0.1 as a Subject Alternative Name (SAN).

Version 10.3, released December 2020

- Before version 11.0, Print Control Service was part of Publishing Platform for Retail (PPR) release and the versions were tightly coupled.
