Web Client Workstations

The technical specifications required for client workstations appear in the following table.

Browser Support for In-Store Publisher

Notes:

- **Mobile support:** While we support these browsers running on mobile devices, this release not completely optimized for small screens/touch-friendly devices.
- **Browser running in Non-Windows OS:** While we support above mentioned browsers in OS other than Windows including mobile devices, client-side printing is not supported.

Application Server

Server requirements apply to a variety of servers, such as web servers for production and staging that host the In-Store Publisher user interface, Lexmark Publishing Services and Publishing Engine services (also called rendering services) that render and distribute print jobs to client machines in an In-Store Publisher system.

Database Platforms

Database servers handle item, batch, sign, and user interface data. Publishing Platform for Retail supports the Microsoft SQL database out-of-the-box, based on reference applications and sample use cases, but does not support other databases. However, custom database integration support may be available. Contact your service consultants for details.

Print Drivers

The technical specifications required for print drivers appear in the following table.

Printer Type	Supported Drivers
Windows Printing	Windows printer drivers are required for GDI and GDI+ output.
PostScript® Printing / Non-Windows	For direct PostScript output, such as in non-Windows environments, a PostScript-enabled and IP-addressable printer is required unless printing to file.
Thermal Direct Printer	For direct custom thermal printer language output, an IP-addressable printer is required unless printing to file. Note: Additional licensing is required for direct output to thermal devices. Contact your service consultants for a list of supported custom printer languages.

In-Aisle Publisher

In-Aisle Publisher is designed for use by employees in store aisles to perform price checks, build batches, and print or publish signs. You can perform these tasks from a device with a built-in scanner or by typing the barcode values using iPhone and Android mobile devices. Note that In-Aisle Publisher runs in the web browser and is not a native application.
